Capital Cares

We are privileged to continue to develop long-term relationships with various partners who meet the spiritual, physical, mental, and emotional needs of individuals and communities. Warehouse Specialists

Responsible for logistics around inbound trucks. The Warehouse Specialists are the hands/feet when it comes to unloading incoming trucks as well as the movement of forklifts within the warehouse. Warehouse Specialists assists the Partner Service Specialists to ensure that unloaded product is sorted into like-kind categories (e.g. appliances, toys, furniture, etc.). Warehouse Specialists also assist the Inventory Coordinators in ensuring that all product is accounted for when inventorying the storage location. They also assist with any necessary palletizing, stacking and shrink wrapping of all pallets.

Partner Service Specialists

Responsible for assisting church and organizational partners when they arrive to pick up product; this may include questions around distribution best practices and questions around item availability. Partner Service Specialists are responsible for preparing product needed for partner pickups. They also assist the Volunteer Coordinators with oversight of volunteers who may be on site to help with warehouse projects (e.g. unloading trucks, sorting product, etc.). Partner Service Specialists may also help bring in new partner organizations who could benefit from distributed material goods.

Inventory Coordinators

Responsible for all inventory-related functions including the assurance that all product received is accounted for. Supply Chain Coordinators ensure all product picked up by partners are accounted for and beneficiary numbers from each partner are recorded for World Vision's Monthly Affiliate Report.

Donation Coordinators

Responsible for sourcing and collecting donations that benefit the operations of Capital Cares. Donation Coordinators may help gather or garner in-kind or monetary donations through corporate or individual partnerships. For example, a donation coordinator may contact corporations that could donate a forklift or industrial shelving to improve operational efficiency. Alternatively, donation coordinators may help solicit financial donations, grant considerations, etc.
